Your matchday ticket(s) allow you to watch both matches however, you will not be permitted to leave the stadium and then re-enter afterwards. Please see the below further key info for matchday:

- On the day turnstiles will open at **11:30** in advance of the first match kicking off at **12:00**
- The Ticket Office (on St Michael's Lane) will open from 10:30 for any Matchday Collections. Matchday Ticket sales will also be available for Standing only as seats have sold out
- Please do not bring bags larger than an A4 piece of paper and bags can be subject to search on arrival at the turnstiles. Children may bring a small backpack with juice and snacks
- There are bar and food concessions within the stadium, payment is by card or smartphone only – the AMT Headingley Rugby Stadium is a cashless venue
- Food and beverage concessions will be open throughout the full stadium and alcohol will be allowed to be consumed in stadium seats – please drink responsibly
- Smoking and vaping is only permitted in designated areas. It is strictly forbidden in stadium stands, toilets and concourses

- The stadium does not allow pushchairs, buggies or car seats in the stands so please do not bring these.
- There is no parking for cars at the stadium or in the surrounding residential areas. Please ensure you do not park on coned roads, residential parking zones or on double yellow lines. Parking wardens patrol the stadium on matchdays.
- Unfortunately, accessible car parking is now full.

- If bringing a flag, please note that your flag's pole cannot exceed 1m in length. The flag's pole material should be plastic and be rounded at the ends

FIRST DIRECT ARENA, LEEDS SUNDAY 5 NOVEMBER 2023

ENGLAND WHEELCHAIR V FRANCE, KO 15:15

Please see the below key info for matchday:

- On the day turnstiles will open at 14:15 in advance of kick-off at 15:15
- The Ticket Office (next to first direct arena Main Reception) will be open from 13:30 for any matchday collections. Matchday ticket sales will also be available at £10 Adults & £5 U16s
- Please do not bring bags larger than an A4 piece of paper and bags can be subject to search on arrival at the turnstiles. Children may bring a small backpack with juice and snacks
- There are bar and food concessions within the venue, payment is by card or smartphone only – the first direct arena is a cashless venue
- Food and beverage concessions will be open in the venue and alcohol will be allowed to be consumed in stadium seats
- Smoking and vaping is not permitted within the first direct arena
- There are over 7,500 car parking spaces within a 15-minute walk of the arena. The arena doesn't have its own car park however there are lots of options nearby:













- Q-Park offers first direct arena visitors exclusive discounted parking at a number of car parks within the city
- Woodhouse Lane Car Park, located on Woodhouse Lane, offers 1272
 spaces and easy access to the ring road
- Merrion Centre Car Park, located on Merrion Way and is adjacent to the arena. It is the closest car park however visitors may experience delays leaving this location due to traffic restrictions on Merrion Way
