Candidates that meet the required criteria must satisfy all sections as set out on this form. The course programme contains high level practical and theory elements consisting of a mixture of interactive discussions, faculty demonstrations and 15-30mins workstation skill assessments.

Candidates who are not HCPC physiotherapists or Doctors may consider it appropriate to complete Level 2 (PHIICIS or ATMIFF) prior to enrolling on the IMMOFP course to gain understanding of the course demands, knowledge and experience. NB L2 alternative qualifications would not enable personnel to enter the field of play to provide treatment and would only be undertaken as part of CPD.

	 A Paramedic must: be registered with the HCPC as a paramedic have evidence of 12 months or more experience in an acute setting hold an Honours Batchelor degree or higher (or other qualifications deemed equivalent) have appropriate professional indemnity insurance hold a current Resuscitation Council Advanced Life Certificate hold a current IMMOFP qualification.
Sports Therapist	 A Sports Therapist must: hold a Sports Therapy degree be a Member of the Society of Sports Therapists be a member of a recognised professional body have appropriate professional indemnity insurance

TWO DAY COURSE

For staff currently employed by an RL Club, payment (£675+VAT) will be made via a deduction from the clubs Central Distributions at the time of booking. Candidates must get permission from their Club before applying. Independent candidates must pay for the course in full (£825+VAT) via BACS within 7 days of receiving confirmation of securing a place by the RFL. We reserve the right to offer your place to another candidate if payment is not received within this time frame.

ONE DAY COURSE

For staff currently employed by an RL Club, payment (£350+VAT) will be made via a deduction from the clubs Central Distributions at the time of booking. Candidates must get permission from their club before applying. Independent candidates must pay for the course in full (£450+VAT) via BACS within 7 days of receiving confirmation of securing a place by the RFL. We reserve the right to offer your place to another candidate if payment is not received within this time frame.

<u>Please inform us of any learning difficulties as you may be entitled to extra time in the written</u> <u>exam. Due to the strict IMMOFP timetable we must be notified beforehand of any disclosures.</u> <u>Disclosures made on the day of the course will not be accommodated.</u>

Please note you have **3 months** from commencement of your first medical position in Rugby League to complete the course.

RE-ACCREDITATION & RE-CERTIFICATION

The IMMOFP qualification now has to be reaccredited with recertification in year 4 as set out below. Reaccreditation will be required for all candidates qualifying for IMMOFP courses:

YEAR 1	Two-day IMMOFP course
YEAR 2	One-day refresher course
YEAR 3	One-day refresher course
YEAR 4	Two-day IMMOFP course

Medical staff have two months from the date of expiry to reaccredit their qualification (or until the first available course if there are no courses available within this time frame) or they will be prohibited from entering the field of play.
