



Minimum Entry Criteria 2020 – Girls Rugby League

To be considered eligible to enter the RFL Girls League a club should meet the following criteria:

- Be a registered member of the Rugby Football League on LeagueNet.
- Be fully compliant with the RFL Mandatory Safeguarding Requirements
- Have paid their league fee of £25 per team, no later than 14 days after their acceptance to participate in the competition
- Have paid their insurance premium (if applicable) by 31/05/2020
- Have a designated treasurer, chairperson, coach, secretary, first aider, who are registered to the Club on LeagueNet
- Ensure that there is an RFL recognised qualified First Aider for each age group, in attendance at every game
- All team head coaches be UKCC Level 2 qualified and licenced/registered on LeagueNet
- Provide qualified (as defined by the RFL Tiers 4-6 Operational Rules) first-aid provision at all fixtures
- Pitch should be fully enclosed, permanently or temporarily, with marked out technical areas
- Be capable of providing separate changing rooms for the home and away teams plus match officials
- All new clubs must be able to demonstrate where they are sourcing players from. (To protect existing clubs from an exodus of players)
- Must have a minimum of 15 players registered on LeagueNet before the commencement of their first league fixture
- Clubs to conduct themselves responsibly and respectfully on social media; particularly with regards to fellow member clubs, the RFL, and Match Officials
- Each Team must have at least 1 designated 'Game Day Manager' to help deter negative touchline behaviour within their own touchline. This role is to be a 'Sole Role' with no other responsibilities on a match day.

Failure to fulfil these criteria may result in membership of the competition being refused or removed. The RFL/Girls League Management Group retains the right to apply dispensation on criteria at their discretion on a case by case basis.
