

- Be a good role model
- Actively discourage foul play and/or sporting behaviour by players
- Treat players equally regardless of their talent and maximise participation and enjoyment for all
- Teach players that honest effort and competing to their best ability is as important as victory
- Encourage players to respect and accept the judgement of the Match Officials
- · Never enter the field of play on matchday
- Never engage in any conduct that could be deemed to be disrespectful of a Match Official
- Never engage in discriminatory or unacceptable conduct of any sort
- Maintain appropriate, professional relationships with players at all times
- Maintain an accurate knowledge of the rules of the game and current coaching methods
- Always consider the health, safety and welfare of the players
- · Ensure my coaching reflects the level of competition being played
- Conduct myself in a manner that demonstrates leadership, respect for the game and for all those that are involved

I understand if I do not follow the Respect Code of Conduct then:

- I may be sin binned or sent off by the Match Official
- I may be disciplined by my Club including being asked to leave
- I may receive a large suspension from the League Disciplinary Committee in line with the On-Field Sentencing Guidelines
- I may be required to undertake further educational courses at my own expense
- I may receive further sanctions from the RFL including being given a Permanent Suspension
 Order from the sport
- I may have my coaching licence withdrawn
