

WOMEN'S SUPER LEAGUE GRAND FINAL FAQs

Tickets are now on sale for the Betfred Women's Super League Grand Final, which will take place at the Totally Wicked Stadium in St. Helens on Sunday 18 September, with kick-off at 3.30pm. Vying for the two finalist spots are Leeds, St Helens, York and Wigan, with the Semi Finals taking place at Headingley Stadium in Leeds on Sunday 4 September.

Beforehand at the Totally Wicked Stadium, two teams will play for the Women's Super League Shield Final at 12.30pm, featuring clubs from Women's Super League Group 2, with Featherstone winning last year's inaugural title and in contention again this year alongside Warrington, Barrow and Bradford.

Tickets are available to buy now for the Totally Wicked Stadium from only £10 Adults, £5 Concessions and FREE for Under 16s at eticketing.co.uk/rugbyleague.

Seats are available to buy in the North Stand and standing places in the West Stand terrace.

What are kick-off times on the day?

On Sunday 18 September at the Totally Wicked Stadium in St. Helens, the Women's Super League Grand Final takes place at 3.30pm with the Women's Super League Shield Final beforehand at 12.30pm.

When can I buy a ticket?

Tickets are available to buy now from £10 Adults, £5 Concessions and FREE for Under 16s at eticketing.co.uk/rugbyleague.

How many tickets can I buy?

There is no limitation on the number of tickets that you can purchase.

Can I choose my seats?

No, seating is allocated as best available by the Block you choose for the North Stand and the West Stand is unreserved standing.

Will my seat be socially distanced?

At this stage the stadium seating will not be socially distanced. Should Covid restrictions change prior to the event, we will notify all buyers of any resulting impact on their matchday.

When and how will I receive my tickets?

Tickets are available only at eticketing.co.uk/rugbyleague and all tickets for this match will be Print@Home. You will receive your Print@Home tickets via email on completion of your purchase. **Please ensure that you have printed off your**

Print@Home tickets before coming to the stadium on matchday – this will allow you to enter the stadium quickly.

Will I need an email address to purchase tickets?

Yes, if buying centrally via [eticketing.co.uk/rugby league](https://eticketing.co.uk/rugby-league), email addresses will now be a mandatory part of the ticket buying process. Customers must supply an email address on every booking, even those by telephone to our Box Office. If you do not have an email address, you can register free at many domains and this only takes a matter of minutes. Or seek permission from a friend or family member to utilise their email address for booking.

Can I leave the stadium and re-enter?

No, once you enter the stadium you will not then be permitted to leave and re-enter.

I require a wheelchair space what should I do?

What food and beverage will be available?

Food and beverage concessions will be open throughout the stadium and alcohol will be allowed to be consumed in stadium seats. **Please note that the Totally Wicked Stadium is cashless and accepts all major bank cards. In addition, you cannot bring your own food and drink into the stadium on matchday.**
